(a good follow-up book from the same group of folks is "The Outward Focused Life" by Dave Workman)



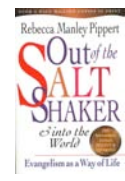
Share Jesus Without Fear

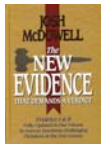

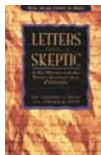
Know Why You Believe

Responding to the questions of open skeptics and ardent believers, Keller explains how faith in a Christian God is a soundly rational belief.



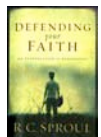
Letters From a Skeptic

Show how to speak the truth of the Gospel effectively and help those who ask you tough questions find the answers---and the God---they seek.



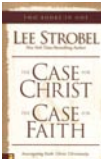
Defending Your Faith
